Academic growth and achievement is a top priority at Epiphany School. Our mission is to provide "a program of academic excellence" that supports each child's individual learning needs and goals.

Our 2021 - 2022 NWEA MAP Growth assessment data shows that we lead the way in all areas of academic achievement: Math, Reading, and Language Usage. Students were tested in the fall and spring to measure their "academic growth" during the school year.

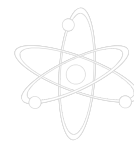
On average, all K-6 cohorts scored higher than their national and Catholic school peers.

Our scores indicate that Epiphany School students are not following the Global Education Pandemic Trend of lower student academic achievement rates; instead, Epiphany students are achieving at higher levels than their cohorts.

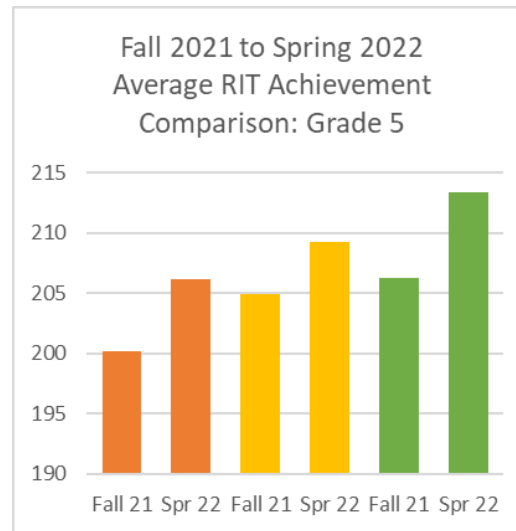

GENERAL SCIENCE



The General Science NWEA MAP Growth assessment is administered in fifth grade only at Epiphany School. These scores show that the students entering fifth grade at Epiphany School started the year with a more advanced general science knowledge than their peers. This knowledge grew during the school year until they exceeded their national and Catholic school peers. Epiphany students left fifth grade ready to learn more advanced scientific concepts!

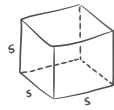
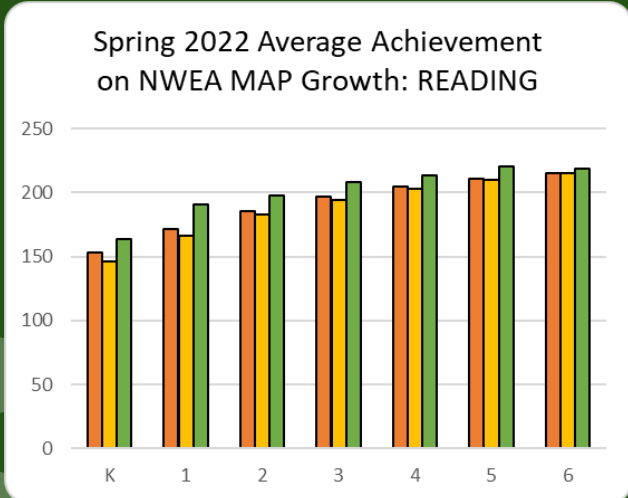
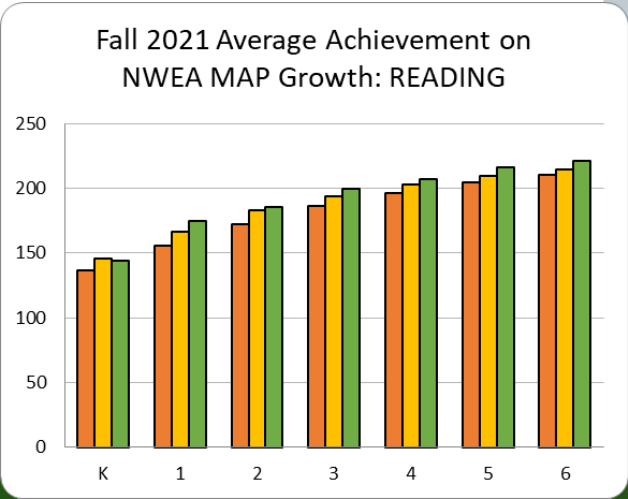

READING

Grades K-6 take the NWEA MAP Growth Reading exam to assess their foundational skills, reading comprehension, and vocabulary skills.

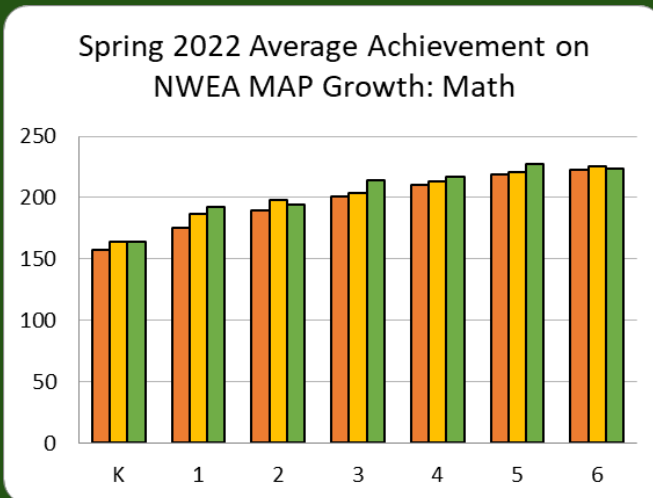
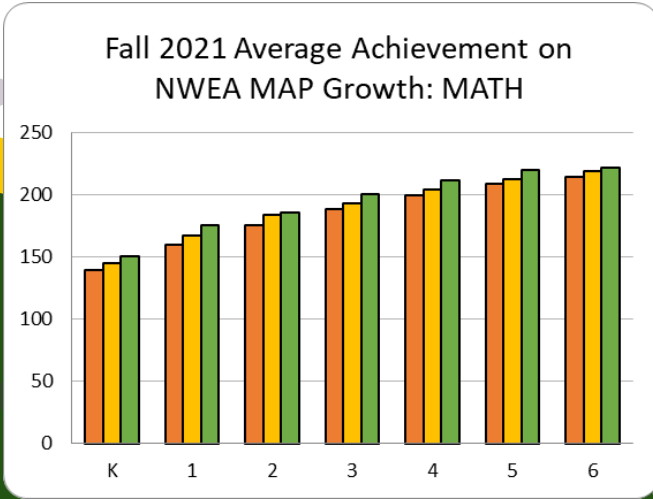
All cohorts demonstrated higher growth in their reading achievement than their national and Catholic school peers.



MATHEMATICS

Grades K-6 take the NWEA MAP Growth Math exam to assess their knowledge of mathematical principals and foundational math skills.

All cohorts demonstrated growth in their math achievement from fall 2021 to spring 2021. Kindergarten, first, third, fourth, and fifth grades also achieved higher than their national and Catholic school peers.



LANGUAGE USAGE

Grades 2-6 take the NWEA MAP Growth Language Usage to assess their knowledge of writing strategies, writing application and style, mechanics, and grammar.

All cohorts from second to sixth grade demonstrated growth in language usage skills. They out performed their national and Catholic school peers.
